## 2021 BUSINESS UPDATE



#### **Site Assessment Course**


- → Launched in March
- →eLearning and instructor-led
- →To date we have had:
  - → 308 in the EN or UK
- →Encourage all staff undertaking site surveys or recommending machines to take this course





#### **Training courses**

- → 3 new courses in 2021 eLearning and Instructor-led
- → Site Assessment March
- Operator Renewal June
- → IPAF PAL+ Course —October
- PDI course updated
- New LOAD and LOAD+ practical assessments
- → MCWP/ Hoist CAP Course
- Operator Renewal practical test on VR Sim launched September





#### **IPAF Powered Access Engineering apprenticeship**

First cohort started in April

→9 apprentices from 8 companies

→ Numbers in October / November cohorts

→3 intakes in October, 28 apprentices from 5 companies

→1 open intake in November, 10 apprentices from 10 companies

#### ePAL Launch

- → Available in over 30 countries
  - → 1 June: UK & Ireland
  - → 27 September: EN speaking countries, including Nordics, Asia and Middle East
- → 22 November is the launch in 15 countries across 6 languages
- Over 65k downloads to date
  - → iOS 58% share
  - → New licences added 47k, existing licences added 16k.









#### Global Safety report published

- Published in 9 languages
- Over 3k views and 800 downloads of the report
- → Data and trends from 2016-2020
- → Focuses on the six main accident types identified through the portal
- The most common causes of fatal incidents were:
- → falls from the platform and electrocutions, both accounting for 23% of deaths globally
- Informing safety campaigns and material





# **Carbon Footprint & Sustainability Project**

- → Carbon Footprint accreditation now completed. IPAF offsetting carbon emissions
- → Member offer through Carbon Footprint Ltd for small and large members
- → Signposting support webpage for members set up by end 2021
- → IAPA Award to celebrate sustainable excellence









# Launch of New IPAF International Safety Committee

- Created from the existing IPAF Accident Work Group
- → First meeting on 22 September at Vertikal Days with representatives from North America, Australia, Brazil, China, Italy and the Middle East
- → Some areas of focus include:
- boosting accident reporting, in particular near-miss incidents new Safety Guidance (MEWPs in public areas) the standardisation of controls





#### **New Member category**

#### Safety Professional

- → Launched in September at Vertikal Days
- Aimed at Health & Safety professionals globally
- → Benefits include:
  - Specific annual webinar
  - Exclusive LinkedIn group to share knowledge
  - Access to members' area of IPAF website and accident portal member's dashboard
- → 11 new members in 7 countries, with 20 in the pipeline, 3 in the UK








#### **Webinars**

- → Seven webinars to date on a range of topics including new IPAF courses, sustainability, MCWPs and the launches of IPAF's Global Safety Report and Rental Market Reports.
- → Over 5k have viewed live or the recordings. Each webinar averages over 750 views from 60 countries.

- → Areas to focus on: Tailored membership benefits Improved support for manufacturer members Engage with CEO/owners to build


