PDO workforce of more than 8,500 employees, comprised of 64 different nationalities, and more than 45,000 contractors.

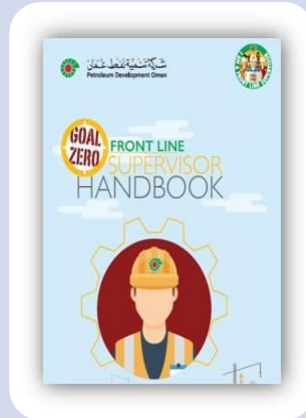

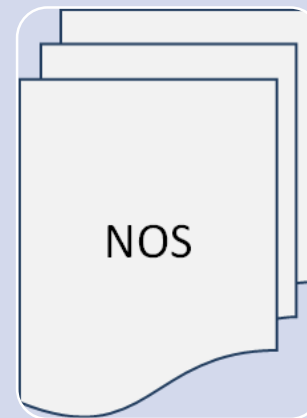

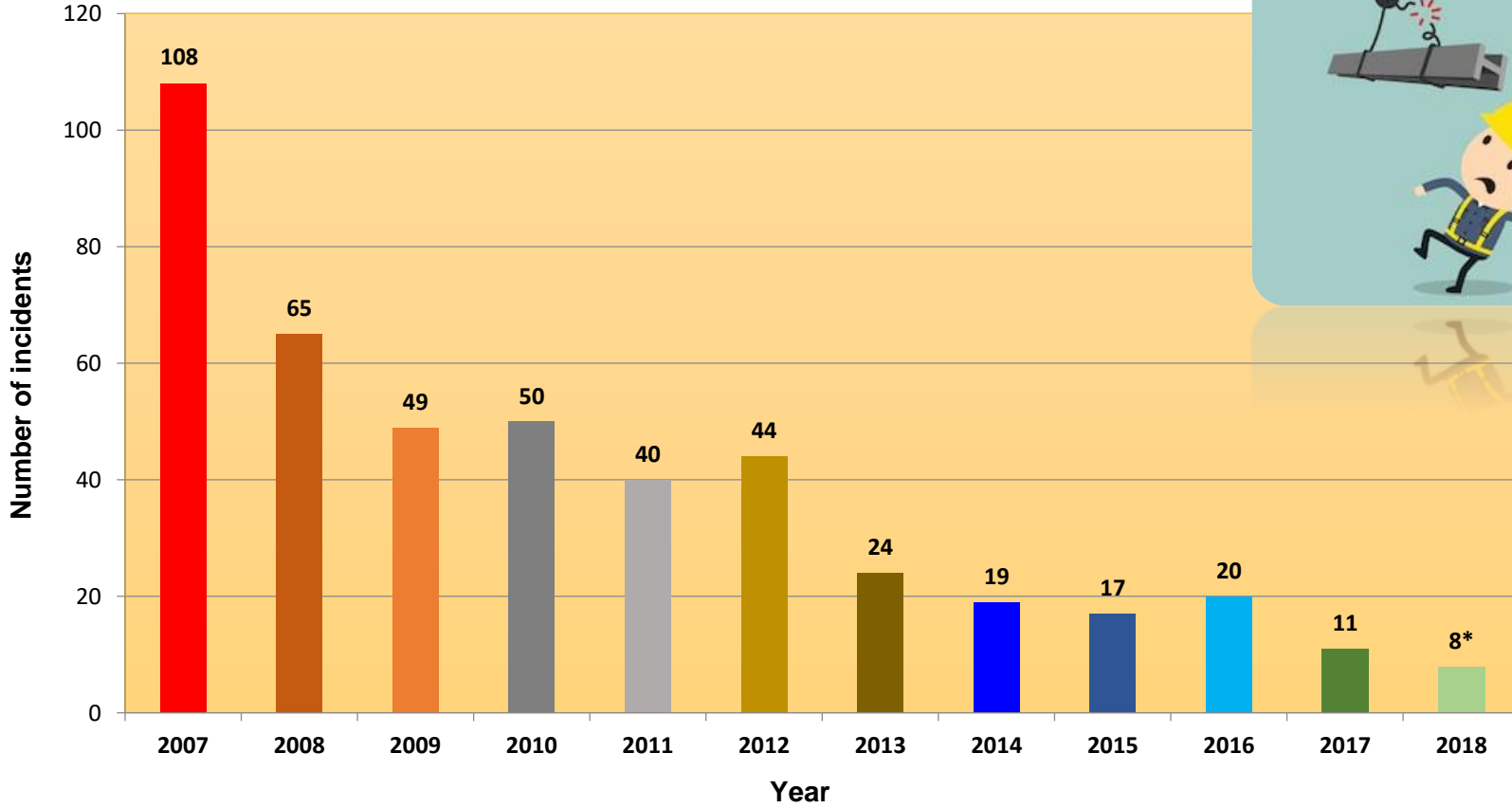
